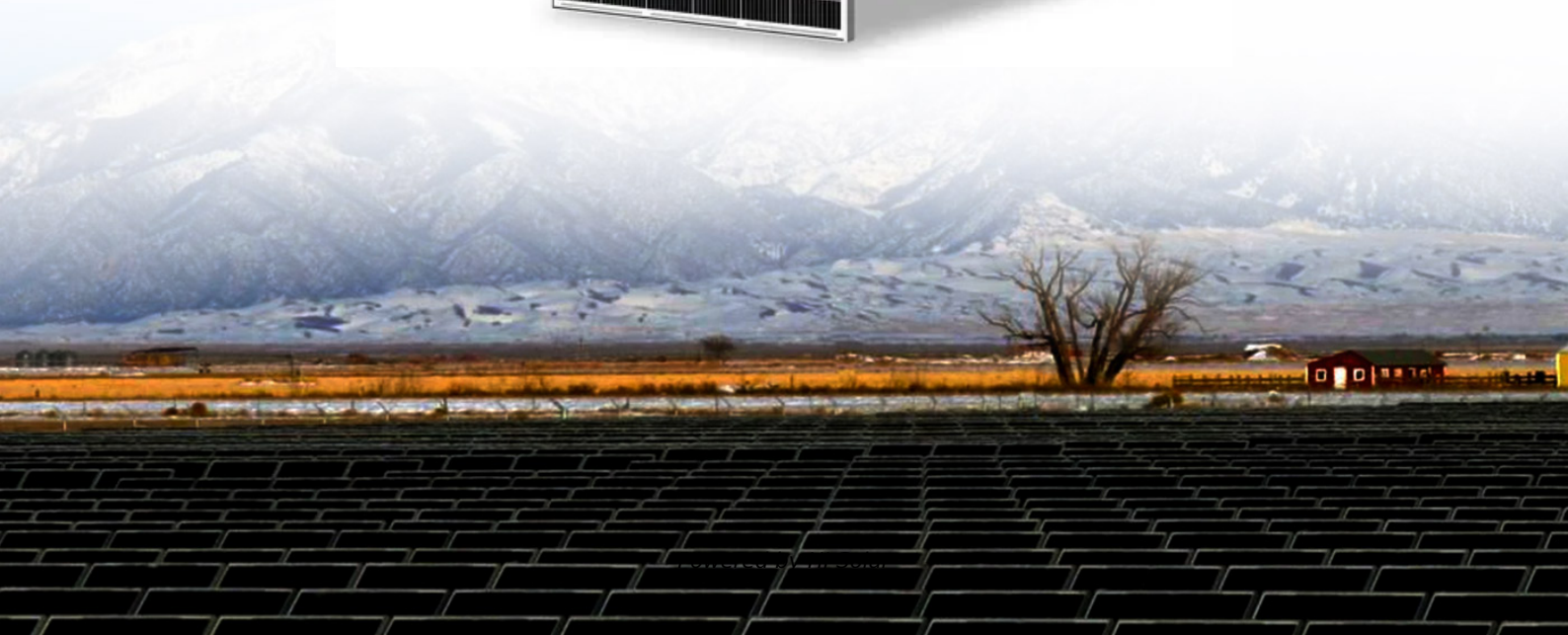
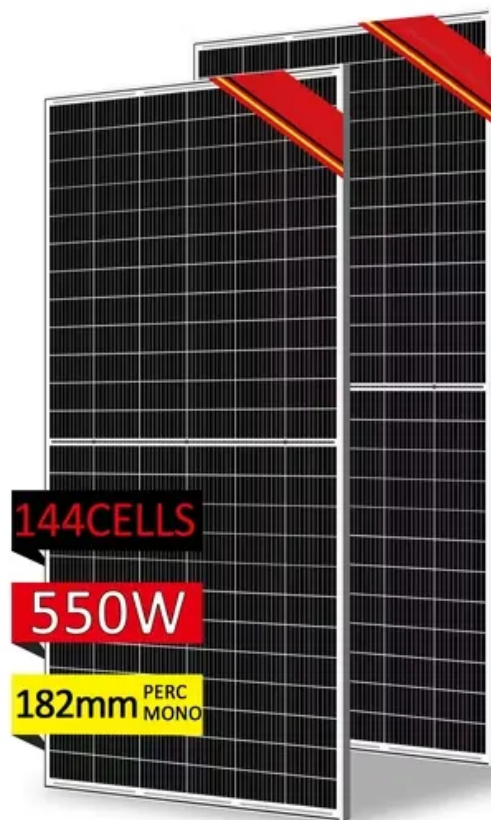


The switch does not store energy after tripping





Overview

What to do if a trip switch keeps tripping?

Unplug all appliances on that problem circuit and switch off any immersion heaters (if you have one). When a circuit breaker trips, the switch does not always move fully to the “Off” position; it often rests in a central or intermediate tripped position that indicates a fault. These problems typically arise from internal electrical faults such as loose connections, faulty wiring, or a tripped GFCI outlet. Whether it’s an overloaded circuit, a short circuit, or something else, understanding why it happens is the first step to fixing it. The photograph above shows three different consumer units and each contains a Main Switch that is designed to trip when there are electrical problems.
